

**Utility Commission**

The regular scheduled meeting of the Delmar Utility Commission was called to order by Vice Mayor Pase In attendance were Commission Member Dewald, Council Member Smith, Deputy Mayor Unsell and Town Manager Bynum- King.

**Approval of Minutes**

Commission Member Dewald made a motion to approve the March, 2019 minutes. Deputy Mayor Unsell seconded the motion which passed with 4 ayes.

**Unfinished Business**

Update on Grove St -Water Main

The Town Manager Bynum-King informed the commission that the contractor has been awarded, he signed notice to proceed. The contractor was supposed to start around 18<sup>th</sup> of March they have not started yet. They have to get a sub-contractor for a portion of the job. Miss Utility has been out and marked Grove Street, looking for work there to start soon.

Update- Back-Up Well

The Town Manager stated that the back up well is online and running well. The public works director said iron level is at 0. The back up well will remain online until 3A is completed. It is having work done to it right now.

**Town Manager's Report**

Town Manager Bynum-King informed everyone that there was a chlorine leak at the water plant. It has been repaired. There have also been issues with soda ash that too has been resolved. Public works personal did 2 taps one on Tenth Street and one on Lincoln Avenue, both on Delaware side. Today the WWTP moved the sludge to drying beds, this is the time of year this is normally done. The WWTP is still working with MDE and the Attorney General's office with the concession order. There was a meeting with engineers to clarify how to deal with issues from the original report.

**Adjournment**

Upon hearing no comments, Council Member Dewald made a motion for adjournment which was seconded by Deputy Mayor Unsell. The motion passed with 4 ayes.
