

Joint Council April 29, 2019

The regularly scheduled Joint Council meeting, comprised of the Mayor & Council of Delmar, DE and the Mayor & Commissioners of Delmar, MD, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. In attendance were Mayor Wells, Mayor Houlihan, Deputy Mayor Unsell, Vice Mayor Pase, Commissioners Scholl, Tucker and Lenox, Council Member Holmes, Clerk of Council Fisher and Town Manager Bynum-King. Absent: Council Members Boyan and Smith.

Called to Order

Mayor Houlihan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
The Joint Council performed the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business

DE Ordinance- # 171- Adopting and Implementing FY'20 Budget

Mayor Houlihan read DE Ordinance #171 for the adopting and implementing the budget for the Town of Delmar, DE for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. Upon hearing no questions or comments from the Council, Mayor Houlihan asked for a motion to approve the First Reading of Ordinance # 171.

Vice Mayor Pase made a motion to accept Ordinance # 171 on its' First Reading and it was seconded by Council Member Holmes. The motion passed with 3 ayes and 2 absent.

MD Ordinance- # 743- Adopting and Implementing FY'20 Budget

Mayor Wells read MD Ordinance #743 for the adopting and implementing the budget for the Town of Delmar, MD for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. Upon hearing no questions or comments from the Commission, Mayor Wells asked for a motion to approve the First Reading of Ordinance # 743.

Deputy Mayor Unsell made a motion to accept MD Ordinance # 743 on its First Reading, which was seconded by Commissioner Scholl. The motion passed with 5 ayes and 0 absent.
