

## **PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Town of Delmar, MD pursuant to a SAFETEA-LU funded grant awarded by the Federal Highway Administration in conjunction with the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration hereby announces that the Safe Routes to School Project (SRTS) has been classified as having no significant environmental impact and the Town has been given approval to proceed to the "project construction phase". Project scope of work is to include construction of ADA compliant sidewalk, curbing and corner street ramps on the "eastside" of S. Second St. from E. State St. to E. Walnut St., Delmar, MD. The Delmar Community Development Office and Davis, Bowen, Friedel, Inc., Engineering will make a "public project approval announcement" and present technical discussion for the scope of work at the Delmar Planning & Zoning Commission Meeting, Thursday, March 23, 2017, 7:00 pm, Delmar Town Hall, 100 S. Pennsylvania Ave., Delmar, MD. Public attendance and input is welcomed and encouraged. A copy of the Project Site Plan can be viewed in the Lobby at Delmar Town Hall. The Town upon receipt of executed "Temporary Access & Construction Easements" and "Waiver of Compensation" from affected property owners along the construction zone will put the project out for contractor bid solicitation. A projected construction timeline and start date will be established at that point. A subsequent announcement of the start date and project traffic pattern changes will be announced to area residents, posted on the Town website ([www.townofdelmar.us](http://www.townofdelmar.us)) under Notice & info) and on its Facebook page prior to commencing construction.
