FENCE REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

- 1. Fence height must be indicated for both front & rear yards if applicable.
- 2. Although there is no setback required for a fence, we <u>recommend</u> that enough room be allowed to be sure that you are not encroaching on your neighbor's yard.
- 3. Fences behind the front yard setback can be up to 6 feet in height.
- 4. Fences within the front yard setback can be no higher than 4 feet.
- 5. Fencing shall be constructed so that any supportive structures, such as bracing or posts, are constructed on the fence facing the use to be screened.
