

## MAYOR & COMMISSIONERS

**June 8, 2020**  
**Via Teleconference**

Mayor Wells called, via teleconference, the scheduled meeting of the Mayor & Commissioners of Delmar, Maryland to order at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, June 8, 2020. In attendance were Mayor Wells, Deputy Mayor Unsell, Commissioners Scholl, Tucker and Lenox, Town Manager Bynum-King, Police Chief Barkley, Town Attorney Benson and Clerk of Council Fisher.

Mayor Wells performed the Pledge of Allegiance.  
The Mayor took a roll call to see if everyone was present.

### **Mayors Comments**

Mayor Wells stated that this past weekend was Graduation Weekend. Originally only a parade was scheduled and then there was to be an on-line graduation ceremony. Then Governor Carney lifted some of the restrictions placed on the State due to COVID-19. A student by the name of Trinity wrote to the school board and asked that since the Governor has lifted some of the restrictions, could there be regular graduation ceremonies? In 9 days, an outdoor graduation stage, arena and spectator viewing was created, keeping in mind social distancing. The Class of 2020 got to graduate together. The parade was held on Saturday.

### **Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Scholl made a motion to approve the May, 2020 minutes as circulated. Deputy Mayor Unsell seconded the motion. By a roll call vote, the motion passed with 5 ayes and 0 absent.

The Department has been asked to provide resources to other points in the County as well as in the State. It has not been necessary at this point.
